Macerata Opera Festival

5 nights - escorted

The Macerata Opera Festival is one of Italy's major summer festivals. Musical standards are very high, with first class casting and programming. Two operas are performed in the impressive open-air Arena Sferisterio and one in the beautifully restored Teatro Lauro Rossi. Our visit to the Le Marche area provides the perfect opportunity to explore this little known region of Italy.

YOUR ACCOMMODATION

We stay for two nights half board and three nights bed and breakfast at the 3-star Hotel La Ginesta, located in the heart of Recanati's historic quarter.

TOUR ITINERARY AND PERFORMANCE DETAILS

Day 1 We fly to Bologna and transfer to Recanati, birthplace of Benjamin Gigli and Italy's greatest poet, Leopardi.

Day 2 Today we visit Urbino, the seat of Federico Montefeltro, Duke of Urbino, and one of the finest Renaissance hill towns in Italy. Here we visit the Palazzo Ducale, the birthplace of Raphael and now a major art gallery.

Day 3 This morning we explore Recanati before continuing to Loreto, a great pilgrimage centre with an important cathedral and a fine art gallery which includes works by Lorenzo Lotto. In the late afternoon we drive to Macerata where we enjoy a walking tour of

the town and stay on for the evening opera. Evening Performance: *Falstaff* by Verdi.

Day 4 Today we visit Ascoli Piceno, another fine Renaissance town with an important cathedral and a remarkable town square. Driving through the unspoilt and undulating countryside of the Marche we stop at Amandola and enjoy spectacular views of the Apennines.

Evening Performance: *Turandot* by Puccini.

Day 5 Our tour of the lovely hill towns of the Marche includes visits to Tolentino, Camerino and Cingoli.

Evening performance: *Carmen* by Bizet.

Day 6 We return to Bologna for our homeward flight.

Stockholm, European Cultural Capital in 1998

Stockholm will be the European Cultural Capital in 1998 - a fitting accolade to this delightful city whose charm is being discovered by more and more people.

Our independent and escorted tours include performances at the Royal Swedish Opera which was founded by King Gustaf III in 1773. The current theatre dates from 1898 and so the opera house celebrates its centenary year in 1998. Both the Royal Opera and the Royal Opera Ballet perform here giving some 250 performances each season.

YOUR ACCOMMODATION

Both the independent and escorted tours stay at the very comfortable 4-star Hotel Sergel Plaza on a bed and breakfast basis with two dinners included. Centrally located, the hotel is less than a ten minute walk from the Opera House.
