

Amsterdam

Amsterdam is famous for its intricate network of canals, crossed by a thousand bridges, and as the diamond capital of the world. Beautiful, tall gabled houses, museums and art galleries line the canals. Explore the city independently or join one of the shore excursions on offer, including a canal boat cruise, a visit to a recreated Dutch windmill village, and a tour to The Hague, the miniature city of Madurodam and Delft, home to the famous blue and white pottery.

Copenhagen

The Danish capital welcomes its visitors with open arms and a harmonious blend of history, sights and fun. The appealing main street, Strøget, is busy with shops, cafes and bankers while the mediaeval quarter is characterised by cobble-stoned streets, half-timbered houses and quiet courtyards.

Why not visit the Tivoli Gardens, the oldest and most charming theme park in the world, with fairground rides, fireworks and cafes all in a delightful setting? Shore excursions on offer include a walking tour, city and harbour boat cruise and a visit to Christiansborg Castle, once the royal residence.

Gdynia

Situated on the shores of the Baltic Sea, Gdynia is a lively Polish town with a bustling harbour and some unique features. A World War II destroyer moored at the northern side of the pier houses a miniature maritime museum and there is a monument to Polish seafarer and novelist Joseph Conrad as well as the Monument of Thankfulness, dedicated to the Soviet people. An excursion to the nearby port of Gdańsk will be available.

Once you have chosen your cruise, you will need to decide which category of cabin you would like. The Ocean Majesty offers a wide range of accommodation so you'll have no problem finding something to suit your needs as well as your budget.

All cabins are well appointed and pleasantly furnished, as you can see from our illustrations. Every cabin has its own private shower, washbasin and wc, telephone, three channels of musical entertainment and individually controlled air-conditioning.

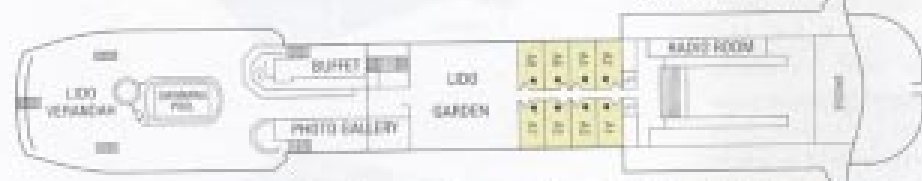
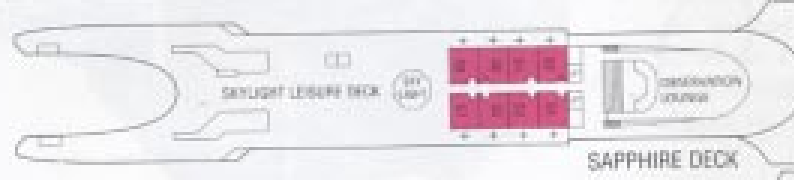
If you intend to make the most of the ship's facilities and the shore excursions on offer, you may only need your cabin to be a base in which to settle at night. The most economical option are inside two bedded cabins, on the Jade Deck in category A. However, if you think you will want to spend more time in your cabin, you may want to pay a little more for an outside cabin with a window or porthole, or for a cabin on a higher deck. Categories D, E and S have a porthole, and all other categories have a larger window.

Deck Plans Cabin

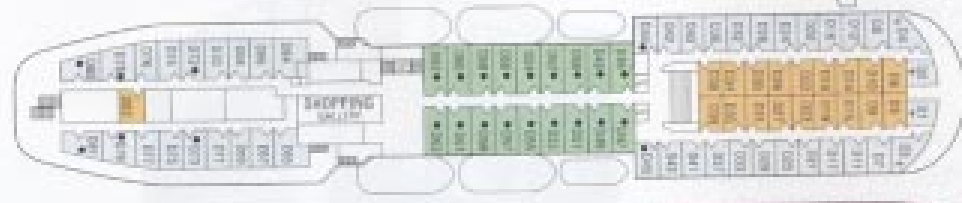

- + double bed



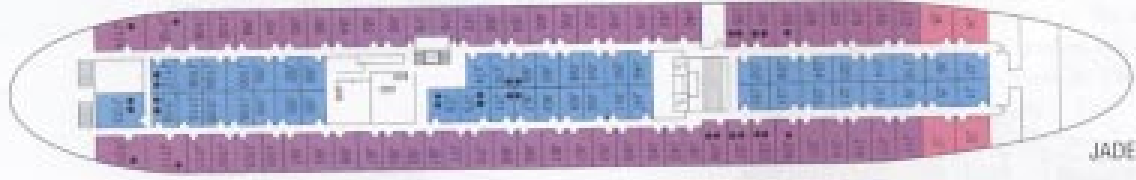
AQUAMARINE DECK

EMERALD DECK

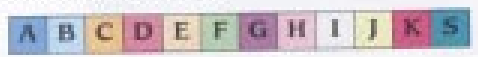


JADE DECK

CABIN CATEGORIES



Cabins D64 and D65 in category I have a slightly obstructed view. Cabins P1, P2, P6, P7 and P8 in category S and cabins P9 and P10 in category E have a restricted view due to the position of the portlights. The view from category F cabins is obstructed by lifeboats. Cabins D16, D17 are smaller than other cabins in category I. Please note that the deckplan is not to scale and does not describe individual cabins which may vary slightly in size and shape.
